1 General Courses

- A minimum number of 20 ECTS per semester (or 40 ECTS per year) should be chosen.
- 0-15 ECTS per semester can be chosen from other programmes.
- Recommended English courses in other related study programmes such as Urbanism, Archaeology, Sustainable Land Management, Geology, Biology, etc.
- Exchange students can be involved in research carried out by the department by taking up a Masters' thesis topic (course Research project).
