# Position of the course

This introductory course familiarizes beginning students with the structure of German and with German vocabulary and teaches them basic linguistic awareness.

#### Contents

Through this course, students gain a basic knowledge of German vocabulary, syntax, and morphology. The focus is on the inflectional system (including morphosyntax) and on contrasts with Dutch.

# Initial competences

Prior command of German is not required, but a sound command of Dutch is necessary. The handbook (with written supplements by the lecturers), which is written in Dutch, is intended to facilitate the transition for Dutch-speaking students with little or no command of German. The lessons are taught in German, from a contrastive perspective based on Dutch. The exam, too, requires a sound command of Dutch.

# Final competences

- 1 To demonstrate a basic knowledge of German vocabulary, syntax and inflection on the level of the teaching materials.
- 2 To apply the above-named basic knowledge in (written) usage.
- 3 To demonstrate basic linguistic intuition and awareness.
