Academic French (spoken and written), introduction to scientific written communication, understanding of the public debate about the evolution and use of the French language.

### Position of the course

This advanced course aims to extend the students' proficiency in the French language with a focus on essay writing and the presentation of scientific subjects. The course helps students gain insight into the place of French in a larger sociocultural context.

Exchange students may take up this course unit, for which no prior knowledge of Dutch is required, as exchange students will be set an alternative exam.

### Contents

- Analysis of the structure of exhaustive scientific texts and the linguistic means to quarantee their cohesion
- · Practical exercises related to these means
- · Review of a number of themes within the field of language and society
