#### Calculation of the examination mark

30% non-periodical

70% periodical

A second exam is not possible for the permanent assessment: in the resit examination period the same mark apllies that was obtained in the first examination period.

The end-of-term assessment can be redone.

If a student does not to participate in the assessment of one component (non-periodical or periodical), passing the course unit as a whole is not possible. If the total score does turn out to be a mark of 10 or more out of twenty, this is reduced to the highest fail mark (9/20).
