Calculation of the examination mark

20% non-periodical, written repeat test at the start of the semester

20% non-periodical: written and oral exercises

60% periodic exam: written exam

The partial mark obtained for the 20% non-periodical part "written repeat test at the beginning of the semester" can and must be retaken in the second examination period: students who have not passed this must retake it in the second examination period. A passed partial mark for this part will be transferred. The partial mark obtained for the 20% non-periodical part "written and oral exercises" cannot be retaken in the second examination period and is therefore transferred to that second examination period.

The periodic part must always be retaken in the second examination period; there is no transfer of partial marks for this part.

If a student does not participate in or has not passed one of the three components, the student can no longer pass the entire course component. If the final score is a grade of ten or more out of twenty, this will be reduced to the highest failed grade (9/20)

Facilities for Working Students
