Advanced course building on Lingála II.

Contents

The goal is to deepen the conversational skills and, in the process, to expand the vocabulary and the grammatical routines.

Initial competences

The student has successfully completed Lingála II.
 Note: The four Lingala courses (I through IV) must be taken consecutively. That is, students must take Lingala II in the academic year and semester immediately following Lingala I, Lingala III in the semester immediately following Lingala II, and Lingala IV in the academic year and semester immediately following Lingala III. In other words, there can be no gap between successive language levels. This applies both to UGent pathway students and to students who choose the Afrikasemester. During a transition period, exceptions may be requested individually from the professor responsible for the course.

Final competences

The student has a more advanced knowledge of the lexicon, the phonology, the morphology and the syntaax of Lingála, as well as of much of the idiomatics of the language.

Possibly 'excursions' (Fedasil) as well: the continuous assessment does not only refer to the inclass seminars, but also possibly includes trips (excursions) to Fedasil in Brussels, where the students practice conversational skills with Congolese asylum seekers who are native speakers of Lingala. The aim is to enable students

to combine language acquisition with concrete social engagement outside the university's walls. Only if the cooperation with Fedasil cannot continue for logistical reasons, this part will be canceled.

50% periodical/end-of-term assessment

A second exam is not possible for the continuous assessment: in the resit examination period the same mark applies that was obtained in the first examination period. The end-of-term assessment can be redone. If students does not to participate in, or fails for, the assessment of one component (non-periodical or periodical), passing the course unit as a whole is not possible. If the total score does turn out to be a mark of 10 or more out of twenty, this is reduced to the highest fail mark (9/20).
