skills by writing a research paper of about 10,000 words: presentation and analysis of academic literature in international languages; basic knowledge of current literary and linguistic theories; writing skills. The Research paper is linked to a Research seminar for each language and/or discipline. See also: http://www.schrijven.ugent.be/onderzoekspaper. Students are also required to attend a research seminar related to the topic of the paper (linguistics or literature of a particular language, or general literature). Students who work on a topic related to Classical languages (linguistics or literature) attend the Seminar of Classical Languages.
