# Position of the course

The student is acquainted with the main fields of study, methods and concepts within the sociology of culture and literature; the student is also acquainted with several actors and networks within the Flemish literar field.

### Contents

Students are introduced into the sociology of literature. Focus is on authors, literary events and magzines, publishers, book-sellers, libraries etc.

# Initial competences

Students have basic knowlegde of comparative literature and are familiar with analyses of literary texts and with how literary traditions function.

- 5 on and advanced level discussing both in written and in spoken texts complex problems within literary and cultural studies
