Position of the course

In this advanced subject the student is asked to demonstrate his/her mastery of a selection of final curricular competencies by writing a Master's Dissertation of approximately 20,000 words (excluding the bibliography) to complete his/her MA studies. Those competencies include being able to think and act in a scientific way, being able to apply research methods and techniques in an advanced setting, and being able to report about one's own research to the profession.

Contents

To be agreed upon with the supervisor. The Master's dissertation will have a comparative and/or literary theoretical dimension. The supervisor will hold a Ph.D. in an area connected to the study programme.

Initial competences

Having successfully completed the bachelor research paper or having acquired the necessary skills by other means.
