## Position of the course

This course is part of Think & Talk, the interfaculty honours programme of the faculties Arts and Philosophy, Law and Criminology, Economics and Business Administration, Psychology and Educational Sciences, and Political and Social Sciences. In a series of debates the students are introduced to perspectives from other disciplines, and they meet experts as well as fellow students from the five abovementioned faculties.

## Contents

The course consists of a series of eight debates, in which one thesis is substantiated by two different lecturers. In each debate lecturers from two of the five participating faculties take part. The first part of each session consists of a statement or position by both lecturers. In the second part a debate with the lecturers takes place, prepared as well as moderated by a selection of students. These eight sessions are preceded by a first introductory lecture and followed by a final creative session. The series are preceded by a workshop How to organise a debate?.
