At the end of the exam period, an oral defense of the master's thesis takes place. This defense lasts 15 minutes and consists of two parts:

- (1) The student presents an infographic in which he/she explains the subject and importance of the master's thesis to a lay audience, in the language of the master's thesis.
- (2) Discussion between the evaluators and the student on various aspects of the master's thesis.

In principle, the interview takes place in the language of the master's thesis. Students can submit an application to hold the evaluation interview in another language (OER, art. 59, §1,5).
