Position of the course

This piece of research has to involve data analysis of some sort (e.g. corpus or dictionary data) coming from his/her own language, or from the language that is the focus of his/her personal research. However, the topic of this research paper should not be the same as that of the masterpaper. (This data-based paper should not be a chapter of the thesis).
