### Contents

The language used to teach is Dutch, but some lessons could be given in French or English.

### Initial competences

At least passive knowledge of English and French is assumed to consult professional literature.

### Final competences

- 1 Responding to the changing relationships between the research practice and the institutional and legal context of the archaeology practice, and being able to provide policy suggestions.
- 2 To participate critically in policy making and planning in archaeological research and heritage management.
- 3 To be able to write down an archaeological report according to the rules imposed by the government.
- 4 To be able to write a scientific archaeological research project.
