Position of the course

This course unit consists of an online application, which aims to enrich the student's study stay abroad by means of assignments. In addition to the online application, there is also a larger assignment, in which the student actively works with the target language.

Contents

The computer application SALSA consists of 9 assignments that increase the quantity and quality of linguistic interaction in the target language and promote cultural integration. The students complete three assignments per month and upload them in the online application. In addition (outside the SALSA application) the students also make a larger assignment (paper) about language, culture and current affairs - in the target language.

Initial competences

No specific starting competences required, except for meeting the conditions to take up the semester abroad (including language proficiency). Students who are in the domestic program can also take the course, but are required to check with the lecturers, first.

Final competences

- 1 To improve the receptive and productive skills in the target language.
- 2 To develop intercultural competences and intercultural sensitivity.
- 3 To develop insight into of interactional situations and develop the pragmatic competence to participate in interactions with native speakers in various (formal and informal) situations.
- 4 To develop socio-affective competences in international communicative contexts.
- 5 To develop an attitude towards lifelong learning.
- 6 To conduct a limited research into language, culture and current affairs and submit this in the target language.
- 7 To make critical use of media in Eastern Europe to gain insight into topical debates
