#### Position of the course

In Swedish Literature I and III, students engage in text-oriented analysis of prose texts; in Swedish Literature II and III, students deepen their knowledge of literary historical developments. This advanced course combines the literary-historical and text-oriented dimensions with specific attention to poetry as genre.

#### Contents

Through active reading and analysis and discussion of representative poetry colections/poems, this course offers a concise historical overview of the most important developments in Swedish poetry history from Bellman to the present day and introduces students to poetry as a specific (?) language act.
