Students who withdraw from one or more components of the evaluation may not be allowed to pass the course. If the final score would exceed 7/20 without having effectively participated in all components, the final score will be reduced to the highest non-deliberative grade (7/20).

If the student scores less than 10/20 for at least one of the components, he/she can no longer pass the entire course unit. If the total score is a grade of ten or more out of twenty, it will be reduced to the highest failing grade (9/20). Partial results of 10/20 or more may be carried over to the second examination period.
