Position of the course

This advanced course aims to provide students with a deeper understanding of the various dimensions of variation within the Dutch language of variationist research.

Contents

Lectures (15 hours) on the diatopic, diastratic, and diafasial variation in Dutch, and on how scholars study this variation.

Initial competences

This course builds upon the competencies acquired in the subject 'Nederlandse Taalkunde: Inleiding tot de sociolinguïstiek'. Proficiency in Dutch at a native or near-native level is essential.

Final competences

- 1 Being capable of describing the basic principles of dialectology, variation linguistics, and sociolinguistics, and situating these disciplines in relation to other linguistic paradigms.
- 2 Being able to critically describe existing variation linguistic structures in Flanders and relate them to socio-historical factors.
- 3 Being able to recognize and identify the main phonological, morpho-syntactic, and lexical variants in the different varieties of Dutch.
- 4 Being capable of identifying manifestations of diglossia, diaglossia, style-shifting, code-switching, dialect leveling, dialect shift, standard language ideology, destandardization, and demoticization.
- 5 Being able to comprehend and explain scientific articles on language variation.
- 6 Having knowledge of methodological approaches in the research on language variation.
