Position of the course

In this course component, the student learns the basic rules for forming and using various word forms, especially verb tenses and moods, so that he/she can understand simple Italian texts and formulate simple sentences in Italian. Exchange students may take up this course unit, for which no prior knowledge of Dutch is required.

Contents

This course component encompasses a set of learning contents related to the basic components of the Italian language. Specifically, the following topics are covered:

- Morphology: Basic rules for forming nouns, adjectives, verbs, articles, adverbs, and pronouns.
- Syntax: General rules for the use of different tenses and moods, and rules for sentence formation.
