This study unit aims at broadening oral skills. Because of the affinity between German and Dutch, special attention is paid to contrastive language acquisition and idiomatic language use.

Exchange students may take up just 1 module, worth 3 credits, of this course unit.

No prior knowledge of Dutch is required for this module.

**Contents**

This study unit is primarily devoted to idiomatic language, oral language skills and the corresponding presentation techniques. Synthesis exercises are organised based on video and audio contributions from the current media and aim at developing/deepening the skill of summarising a text orally and using good voice

and speaking technique. Additionally, students read newspaper articles, process the content into an oral presentation, initiating a guided group discussion on the theme of the articles on Ufora.
