Position of the course

This course unit aims to familiarise students with Italian history, with a view to acquiring a broad background knowledge. Within this subject, the importance of the past for understanding contemporary Italian society is made clear. This subject also offers students the opportunity to enrich their vocabulary immensely, as they encounter specific terms related to institutions, politics, art, religion and economics.

Contents

This course unit focuses on the history of Italy's political and economic structures and on the main cultural developments. Emphasis is placed on the links between past and present. Certain historical periods and phenomena receive special attention (e.g. the birth of the Papal State, the Renaissance, the unification and the Roman Question, fascism, the economic miracle, the end of the Prima Repubblica), but no era is skipped. In this way, this course unit complements the subject *Geschiedenis en cultuur van Italië: inleiding*, which focuses mainly on geography, contemporary society and the history of the Italian language. The course is structured chronologically.
