Non-periodical evaluation: participation (participation in a class discussion of the paper outline), presentation (of paper outline), assignment (paper)

Calculation of the examination mark

Periodical evaluation: 30%

=> oral assessment of the read articles and the assignment (paper)

Non-periodical evaluation: 70%

=> participation: 10%

=> presentation: 10%

=> assignment: 50%

If the student is absent without a valuable reason at or does not take part in (a part of) the assessment moments, then he or she can not pass and will, if his or her total would be more than 8/20, get a final score of max. 7/20.

Nota bene: if a student violates the d/t-rules two times or more in one of the written part (assignment), the score for that specific part will be a maximum of 9/20. In the evaluation of the written part, content, style, spelling and the incorporating and correct reporting of the used sources will be taken into account.
