"Russian : Oral Skills" (R3MV) aims to practice various types of listening skills and teach students how to structure thoughts and orally convey them in an adequate and fluent way. They are familiarized with cultural aspects of oral skills in Russian and learn to use specific heuristic tools.

### Contents

"Russian : Oral Skills" (R3MV) is ordered thematically : a new theme or text genre is introduced every second class. The main focus is on language proficiency, both on the lexical and grammatical level.
