Position of the course

The bachelor project concerns independent work, followed by a written and an oral report. The teachers of the bachelor education propose subjects for such projects. The bachelor project relates to a general course, to an optional course, or to a broadening course mathematics of the bachelor education.

Contents

The student investigates a subject related to a course. This investigation can take many forms: a theoretical study of a subject (e.g. based on a book, a book chapter or a scientific paper), an investigation with more practical work (programming, Sage, statistical analysis,...), ... The bachelor project finishes with a short oral presentation.
