Reception of ancient and medieval thought systems

**Situering**

This course is one of the eighteen research seminars that constitute the core of the master programme. Depending on initial qualifications, students enrol for three or five such research seminars.

**Inhoud**

The focus will be on Heraclitus and the way "the obscure" philosopher from Ephesus was interpreted through the ages: with texts from Plato to Heidegger addressing the fragments of the Presocratic philosopher, combined with contemporary academic interpretations.

**Begincompetenties**

Knowledge of ancient and medieval thought systems at intermediate level.

Competence in philosophical writing and argumentation.

**Eindcompetenties**

- 4 Ability to report on research orally in a clearly-understood manner.
