The topics will range from philosophy and religion to art history, archaeology, history and literature, and span the entire Asian continent, from the Middle East to Japan. - Group discussions/participation: in groups, students discuss the material to develop their own research questions, hypotheses, etc.
- Guided self study: the teacher gives the students articles, videos, etc. to go through prior to the lectures.

## **Toelichtingen bij de evaluatievormen**

- Exam: written exam based on lectures and reading materials
- Participation: the student develops other research questions, hypotheses and methodologies to suit, based on the material presented, with special attention to valorization.

## **Eindscoreberekening**

- Exam: 80%
- (Group) presentation and participation: 20%

Students who do not take part in the assessment of one or more parts of the course evaluation or obtain a mark of less than 10/20 for one of its parts cannot pass the course evaluation.

Should the average mark be higher than 10/20, the final mark will be reduced to the highest non-pass mark (= 9).
