The term "Asian century" when referring to this twenty-first century is suggestive of the projected demographic, economic, political, and cultural dominance of the Asian continent, the largest and most diverse continent of our planet. Knowledge and understanding of Asia, a must for any world citizen, is the ultimate outcome of academic research in Asian Studies. In this course, you will be introduced to current research topics on Asia and its regions and reflect on how they matter to us today. The topics will range from philosophy and religion to art history, archaeology, history and literature, and span the entire Asian continent, from the Middle East to Japan. Toelichtingen bij de didactische werkvormen

- Lecture: the lecturer gives an exposé on their background material (very broad state of the art), research questions, hypotheses, methodologies and outcomes
- Seminar: in groups, students discuss the material to develop their own research questions, hypotheses, etc.
- Independent work: the teacher gives the students articles, videos, etc. to go through prior to the lectures.
