Translation English - French

Situering

This course is aimed at students who want to improve their skills as translators from English to French

Inhoud

The course is composed of theory and practical sessions. On the one hand, students gain an insight into the issues surrounding translation from English to French. Attention is then paid to the specific differences between English and French.

Students will learn the major difficulties in the book 'les Règles d'or de la traduction' and prepare exercises at home. They will also prepare translations individually and in groups. The students will present their translations, which will be followed by a discussion and comments from the teacher during the seminars.

Begincompetenties

The student has a native-speaker command of French (C2 is also allowed) and an advanced level of English.

Students have to take an admission test so that their level can be assessed.
